## Registration for Fall 2005 is here!

It is time for registration! You will be able to register for Fall 2005 has started. Registration is online using Weblink ([www.udmercy.edu/weblink](http://www.udmercy.edu/weblink)). *In order to register you must first contact your advisor to discuss your progress and plan of work.* The advisor must then authorize your registration. Only then will you be able to register online using your 7-digit ID number and your permanent Weblink PIN number.

### *Who is my advisor?*

If you are a Family Nurse Practitioner student, your advisor is Janet Baiardi. If you are a Health Systems Management student, your advisor is Julia Stocker. Please contact your advisor to discuss your plan of work and obtain the authorization to register. This will secure your place in the classes you select.

### *What if I can't find my PIN number?*

Students have been previously sent their WebLink PIN numbers. These are permanent PIN numbers and are not re-issued each semester. If they have forgotten or lost them, they can send an e-mail message from their UDM e-mail account to [weblinkpin@udmercy.edu](mailto:weblinkpin@udmercy.edu) or they can bring picture ID to the ITS department on the ground level of the Fisher Administration Building.

### *How do I know what classes are offered?*

### *Will there be online classes offered?*

There are online classes both fall term. HLH 550, Research Methods and HLH 570, Health Care Policy and Delivery Issues will be offered online in fall. Remember if you are interested in an online class, REGISTER EARLY as class sizes are limited and it is expected these classes will fill early.

### *What if I have a hold on my account?*

If there is a hold on your account you will not be able to register. This can hinder your ability to secure a place in a chosen class. Common reasons for holds are related to financial issues. Your web account will inform you of any holds. Please
